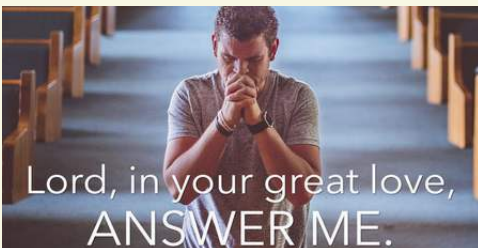

## School News

Many of you have probably heard or seen the trucks outside the school working this past week. I would like to inform you of the details of what happened because I know there is much speculation.

Late in the evening of June 10, after a hard rain (5 inches in places), I decided to check our security cameras. I discovered water in the school building. A small, amazing crew of people and Father Marc worked to fight the water. The gym floor had standing water (which came under the doors of the courtyard). The basement cafeteria also had 6.5 inches of water, two broken windows, and standing water in the carpeted hallway, library/reading room, counselor's room, and the 1st grade classroom. We brought in a large pump to remove the dirty water from the cafeteria as fast as we could. The courtyard was flooded, along with Washington Street. It was hard for the water to drain away. I called SERVPRO to come the next morning to help with drying and cleanup. I also called our gym floor company, Stalker Flooring. Both groups showed up first thing on June 12. Our insurance company was also notified first thing on Thursday.

We have investigated many reasons why this situation occurred. We found a broken pipe in the ground outside the school—Hollister's is fixing that. We also discovered lots of white rock in our pipes, probably from the alleyway washing toward our school and from the snowplow pushing rock from the alley over the top of our drains. The City of Macomb is also investigating the lack of drainage on Washington Street, which is where our water drains. We are currently working on cleanup. Carpet tiles were removed, and everything will be professionally cleaned and disinfected. The gym floor has been removed, and there will also be an asbestos abatement process in the gym due to asbestos tiles coming up. I have Benton Engineering coming to look at the bigger issues of why this has happened. Our insurance company has been wonderful to us. All damage from the flood, except our deductible, will be covered. We will need to pay for our broken pipe out of pocket and for Benton Engineering to help us solve why this is happening.

Thank you for your prayers during this time. It has been a lot to work through. I really LOVE being the principal of our awesome students... but being the principal over a building is not as much fun. If you have any questions, please reach out to me! I am happy to talk. I really want to thank ALL who have helped me up to this point! You are awesome!
